The aim of this award is to engage and support trainee gastroenterologists and hepatologists in quality improvement projects that will bring about real benefits for patients and healthcare professionals alike.



What are we looking for?



The project must address an area of clinical need within gastroenterology and hepatology and have clear patient benefit. It must also be entirely based within the UK and for a period of one year only.



Applications can be made for the full £10,000 or for smaller amounts. All relevant non-capital project costs can be funded under this award.

Trainee Audit/QI Awards Criteria

Trainees who have an established project or fellowship that is fully funded are not eligible for this award unless the funding is to contribute.
